12 credit hours required in one of the following languages: Arabic, French, Spanish. All courses must be in a single language.

If foreign language placement is 202 or above, 305/306 will be required and additional courses that focus on culture and/or professional topics from the following to total minimum of 12 credits:

SPAN 301, 321, 350, 351, 356, 357, 358, 406, 409, 420, 450, 451, or 465

Notes:

1. No courses may be taken as pass/fail.
2. A 3.0 GPA in the courses within the certificate is required.
3. Certificate credit can be shared with a major, or minor, or other certificate.
